

## SIGNS YOUR PET NEEDS TO SEE THE VET

○ Vomiting
○ Diarrhea
<ul> <li>Unintended weight loss</li> </ul>
Change in appetite—decreased or increased
O Change in normal activity level: lethargy, hyperactivity, or restlessness
○ Limping
<ul> <li>Sudden inability to move back legs</li> </ul>
O Crying in pain when touched
<ul> <li>Clumsy or disoriented behavior</li> </ul>
○ Seizures
Any loss of consciousness
O Coughing, especially at night
Panting in a cat
Any difficulty breathing or labored breathing
<ul> <li>Any blue, purple, or pale hue to the tongue and gums</li> </ul>
○ Sudden collapse
Excessive drooling
<ul> <li>Straining in the litter box without producing any urine</li> </ul>
Crying out while urinating
O Change in urination: location, frequency, amount, color, smell
<ul> <li>Bloated abdomen</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Sneezing excessively</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Uncontrolled bleeding</li> </ul>
Nose-bleed or bruising anywhere on body
Any unusual odor
○ Hair loss
<ul> <li>Runny eyes or nose</li> </ul>
<ul><li>Squinting</li></ul>
